This position is key to successful completion of technical and custodial work during the day time and afternoon shifts within the H2O Adventure + Fitness Centre. The Facility Operations Supervisor is responsible for various maintenance functions involving building and maintenance repair, pool heating and filtering equipment and custodial tasks as required. Reporting to the Facility Operations Managers, the Facility Operations Supervisor will provide guidance and leadership to rest of the team who works within the department.

Major Responsibilities and Abilities:

- A good working knowledge of swimming pool heating and filtration systems and the measurement and handling of chemical purification additives
- Working knowledge of building maintenance and cleaning routines
- Knowledge of fitness equipment and repairs to equipment.
- Ability to troubleshoot a variety of mechanical issues.
- Knowledge of the rules and precautions necessary to avoid accidents in and around municipal facilities and equipment
- Ability to maintain acceptable standards of swimming pool water quality and cleanliness and condition of related facilities
- Working knowledge of the methods, materials, tools and practices used in servicing and making minor building and equipment repairs
- Ability to assist in training seasonal employees and volunteers
- May be required to wear respirator equipment and shall meet requirements of a complete fit test. ie: clean shaven where respirator seals the skin
- General knowledge of biological and social factors associated with working shifts
